Presentation in Asia Cornea Society in Thailand

Our CEO/Founder Dr. Shimizu traveled to Bangkok, Thailand to present a case report made using telemedicine.

On November 25, 2022, at "The 8th Asia Cornea Society Biennial Scientific Meeting" held in Bangkok, Thailand, Our CEO/Founder Dr. Shimizu presented a case report titled "A single case of Stevens-Johnson syndrome dry eye that recovered by telemedicine".

Stevens-Johnson syndrome(SJS) is an autoimmune disease that causes severe dry eye disease (DED). The treatment is antiinflammatory therapy, but the incidence of this disease in Japan is estimated to be about 3.1 cases per million people per year, and it is not often seen in general outpatient clinics. In this report, we have done a doctor-to-doctor (D to D) teleconsultation between the Department of Ophthalmology at Tachikawa Hospital and the DED Outpatient Clinic at the Department of Ophthalmology, Keio University School of Medicine, using the portable and recordable slit-lamp device Smart Eye Camera. We experienced a case of SJS-related DED that progressed well after early specialized therapeutic intervention using D to D teleconsultation system.

In Thailand, we met with a lot of ophthalmologists and medical professionals. We have a positive perspective for launching some pilot studies with some universities in Thailand. Also, having conversations with medical startups from Thailand, we could have a positive perspective for using Smart Eye Camera in the field of telemedicine, in collaboration with them!

OUI Inc. will continue to work with local ophthalmologists and medical professionals to overcome preventable blindness and visual impairment in Thailand and around the world.
