OUI Inc.'s Smart Eye Camera expands to Indonesia and East Timor

On March 18 and 19, Dr. Shimizu and Mr. Nakayama from OUI Inc. were invited to the International Ophthalmology Symposium Bali 2023 held in Bali, Indonesia.



On the first day of the Symposium, Dr. Shimizu did a presentation titled "Innovative Artificial Intelligence-based Cataract Diagnostic Method". On the second day, Dr. Shimizu and Mr. Nakayama did a presentation titled "Start Up Company in Ophthalmology" and introduced OUI Inc.'s activities to the participants in the Symposium. More than 350 local and international ophthalmologists and healthcare professionals attended the conference, which was the first face-to-face conference in Indonesia since the pandemic.

On March 17, Dr. Eisuke conducted a courtesy visit to Udayana University and its affiliated hospital, Sanglah Hospital, to confirm the progress of the joint research using our Smart Eye Camera. He also provided a lecture on our Smart Eye Camera to 48 residents at Udayana University. We will continue to collaborate with them to promote joint research.

On March 23 and 24, Mr. Nakayama of OUI Inc. visited East Timor and introduced our Smart Eye Camera to the ophthalmologists/optometrists in the country. East Timor currently has a population of 1.32 million, and there are only four active ophthalmologists in the country. According to them, Smart Eye Camera will do good and be helpful in their daily activities, since there is no complicated electrical structure on the hardware and it is easy to use.

There are not enough ophthalmologists and optometrists in East Timor, so it is important to find ways to involve medical staff with no ophthalmology knowledge into their activities and empower them. From this perspective, they said that our Smart Eye Camera would be helpful. We plan to accompany their outreach activities in rural areas and demonstrate to the local staff on how to use our Smart Eye Camera directly in the near future.
