OUI Inc.'s Smart Eye Camera expands to Nepal!

In June and July 2023, members of OUI Inc. visited Nepal twice!



Nepal is home to a series of 8,000-meter peaks, including the world's highest, 8848-meter Mount Everest (Sagarmatha). About 80% of the country's land area is covered by mountains and hills. In many such mountainous areas, there are no doctors available; and in a case of emergency, the only option is to call an ambulance, which can take up to several hours to arrive.

OUI Inc. has been working with a local partner, the BM Foundation, for two years on a pilot demonstration using the Smart Eye Camera. Now, with the aim of further propagating the collaboration, OUI Inc. will join BM Foundation in many joint ventures. The SEC screening in schools from recently was one of them!

First, Dr. Rohan of OUI Inc. visited Nepal from June 21 to 23 to conduct screenings using the Smart Eye Camera at three schools in the town of Chapakot, a 6 to 11 hour drive, depending on traffic, or a 25-minute flight from the capital city of Kathmandu. The schools enroll many children from 4 to 16 years old. Since Nepal's second language is Hindi and Dr. Rohan, who has roots in India, can speak Hindi, he was able to communicate smoothly with the children and screen at a rate of over 100 children per hour.

From July 2 to 5, Shintaro Nakayama, COO of OUI Inc. also visited Nepal, where with the support of the BM Foundation, he met with local medical equipment companies and exchanged views on the future direction of collaboration with the BM Foundation. We also visited an elementary school and a junior high school located 10 km north of Kathmandu by car and conducted screenings using the Smart Eye Camera. Dr. Buddhi, a representative of the BM Foundation, gave us a letter of appreciation. The team used the time outside of screening to visit the ophthalmology department at Teaching Hospital, the largest hospital in Nepal, and decided to discuss the possibility of collaboration in the future through joint research projects using the SEC and eye camps.

Through this visit to Nepal, we were able to show the potential of the Smart Eye Camera to many people in Nepal! OUI Inc. will continue to work with local ophthalmologists and medical professionals to take on the challenge of overcoming preventable blindness and visual impairment in Nepal and beyond!
