The Role of OUI Inc.'s Smart Eye Camera on Miyake Island



On August 4th, Ms. Tozawa, OUI Inc.'s business associates and Mr. Keino visited Miyake Island. Miyake Island is a remote island located in the Pacific Ocean, 180 kilometers south of Tokyo, with a population of approximately 2,000 residents. It takes approximately 6 and a half hours to reach the island by ferry from Tokyo.

They visited the Miyakejima Central Clinic, the only clinic in Miyakejima. While the clinic is staffed by three doctors, there is no ophthalmologist on staff. Therefore, aside from the semi-annual ophthalmological examinations conducted by visiting ophthalmologists, general practitioners handle symptoms such as foreign body sensations, eye itching, and pain as part of their emergency response.

Before the introduction of our Smart Eye Camera, the clinic only had a slit-lamp microscope, which the resident doctors used to manage these cases, and they had no choice but to transport the more urgent patients to Tokyo. However, with the introduction of our Smart Eye Camera, there have been cases where patients who would have otherwise been transported to Tokyo were successfully treated on the island. Cases that resident doctors cannot diagnose are now consulted with ophthalmologists using our Smart Eye Camera remotely.

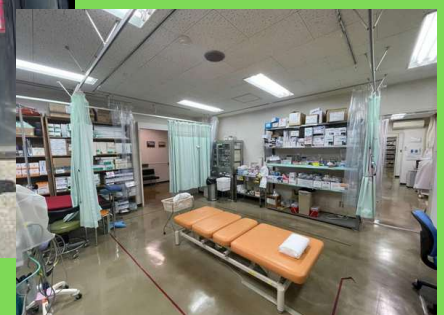
Dr. Nojiri, the clinic's director, mentioned that since ophthalmology requires a high level of specialization and there are many patients with concerns about their vision, it is reassuring for both doctors and patients to be able to receive advice from ophthalmologists at a remote location.

OUI Inc. will continue to collaborate with various research and medical institutions, striving to overcome preventable blindness and visual impairments, both domestically and internationally, while producing evidence-based solutions, including those on remote islands.
